

Golf Cart Rules

1. Keep motorised carts at least 15 metres (where practical) from tees, greens and bunkers except when on a formed path. Carts are NOT permitted inside the marked **Blue** lines or roped areas.
2. DO NOT cross **Blue** lines
3. Do Not Drive Over Any Mounds On The Course Or Slopes Around Tees And Greens.
4. Motorised carts are to be driven on cart paths provided and park Indian file at tees and greens on the paths and follow directional signs where displayed.
5. Drive carts on the closely mown portions of the fairways or outside the tree lines, stay out of roughs on edges of fairways and green and tee surrounds.
6. Park carts to the REAR OF GREENS or to the side leading to the next tee, NEVER in front of greens. This will greatly assist the Pace of Play.
7. All cart signage is to be obeyed at all times.
8. All cart signs and ropes and stakes are to be treated as immovable obstructions and relief may be taken under rule 16-1. They are NOT to be removed for any reason.
9. If course conditions are wet, carts should only travel on the driest and firmest parts of the golf course and should stay away from critical golf areas as much as possible.
10. Restrictions may apply in wet and frosty conditions (see notice boards).

All cart drivers are required to comply with these rules to protect the golf course from damage.

Cart drivers who do not strictly comply with the rules will be liable to have permission to use carts revoked.
